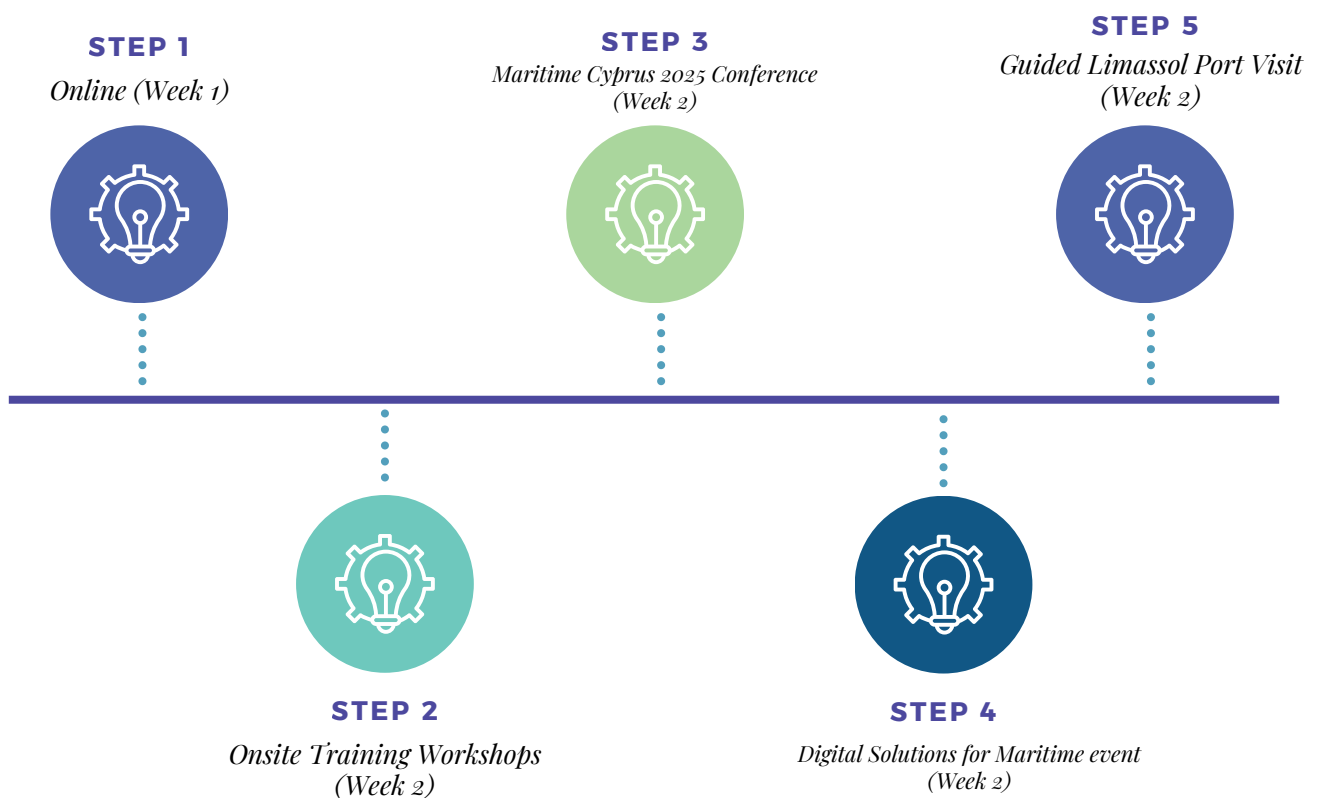
Summary

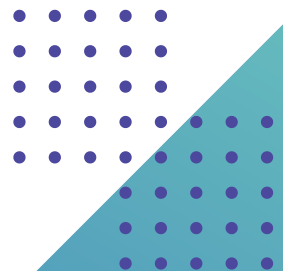

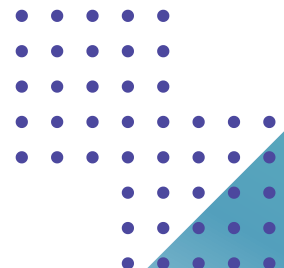

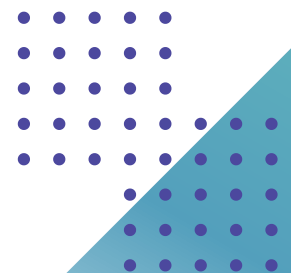
